Annual fire drill on cavern site

Joint exercise of local and municipal fire brigades on 3rd November 2018

Bremen, October 29, 2018: On Saturday, November 3, 2018 from 09:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. the annual exercise of the fire-brigades of the municipality Friedeburg takes place on the cavern site in Etzel.

This fire drill is carried out regularly by the fire brigades on or near the cavern facilities.

Around the terrain on the Bitzenlander Weg smoke might be detected. Traffic on federal and regional roads will not be restricted by this.

Etzel-Kavernenbetriebsgesellschaft mbH & Co. KG is a joint venture established between BP Europe SE, Ørsted and Gazprom Germania. At its Etzel location (in the Municipality of Friedeburg, close to Wilhelmshaven) the company operates a natural gas storage in underground caverns.

This plant operated by EKB Storage with currently nine underground caverns in operation, is one of the most efficient commercial storage facilities in Germany. Per hour 450,000 cubic meters of natural gas can be injected and a maximum of 800,000 cubic meters withdrawn.
