### EKB offers additional Withdrawal Capacity as of June 2018

**Bremen, June 2018:** After recently performed optimization activities EKB will offer as of Monday, June 11th 2018 additional 10,000 Nm<sup>3</sup>/h Withdrawal Capacity.

As a result EKB is able to deliver 800,000 Nm<sup>3</sup>/h of Withdrawal Capacity in total.

#### Company Information:

Etzel-Kavernenbetriebsgesellschaft mbH & Co. KG is a joint venture established between BP Europe SE, Ørsted and Gazprom Germania. At its Etzel location (in the Municipality of Friedeburg, close to Wilhelmshaven) the company operates a natural gas storage in underground caverns.

This plant operated by EKB Storage with currently nine underground caverns in operation, is one of the most efficient commercial storage facilities in Germany. Per hour 450,000 cubic meters of natural gas can be injected and 800,000 cubic meters withdrawn.
