Maintenance Measures on Cavern Site

EKB Carries out Annual Routine Works

Bremen, September 6, 2018: From September 14 - 28, 2018 the Etzel-Kavernenbetriebsgesellschaft carries out the routinely annual maintenance works on site and on VT 8 and VT 16.

During this time the facility will be switched off.

These works may cause an increased noise emission. Furthermore, additional illumination is required.

With regard to the neighbours these impacts will be kept as low as possible.

The regulating authorities were informed.

Etzel-Kavernenbetriebsgesellschaft mbH & Co. KG is a joint venture established between BP Europe SE, Ørsted and Gazprom Germania. At its Etzel location (in the Municipality of Friedeburg, close to Wilhelmshaven) the company operates a natural gas storage in underground caverns.

This plant operated by EKB Storage with currently nine underground caverns in operation, is one of the most efficient commercial storage facilities in Germany. Per hour 450,000 cubic meters of natural gas can be injected and a maximum of 800,000 cubic meters withdrawn.
