EKB auctions Working Gas Volume of 50 GWh

Bremen, August 2020: EKB will market an additional Working Gas Volume of 50 GWh for this storage year. This additional capacity will be made available in the period from October 1, 2020 at 6:00 a.m. until April 1, 2021 at 6:00 a.m.

As a special feature this year, the 50 GWh Working Gas Volume will be initially filled with 22 GWh Working Gas.

Etzel-Kavernenbetriebsgesellschaft mbH & Co. KG is a joint venture established between BP Europe SE, Ørsted and Gazprom Germania. At its Etzel location (in the Municipality of Friedeburg, close to Wilhelmshaven) the company operates a natural gas storage in underground caverns.

This plant operated by EKB Storage with currently nine underground caverns in operation, is one of the most efficient commercial storage facilities in Germany. Per hour 450,000 cubic meters of natural gas can be injected and 800,000 cubic meters withdrawn.
